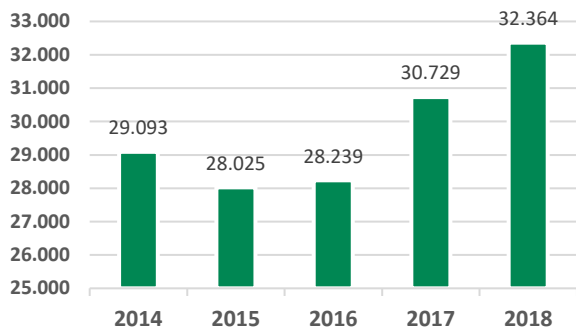

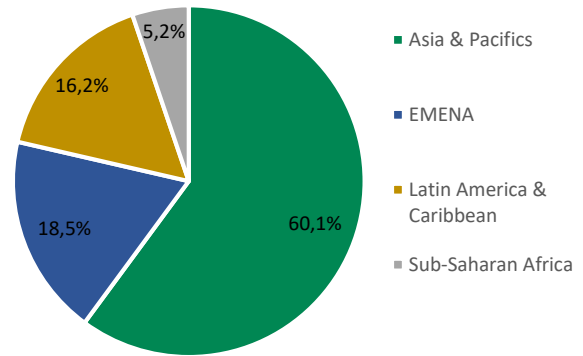

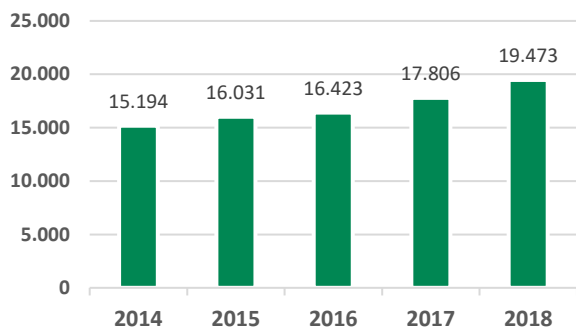
### GDP DEVELOPING COUNTRIES IN BILLION USD



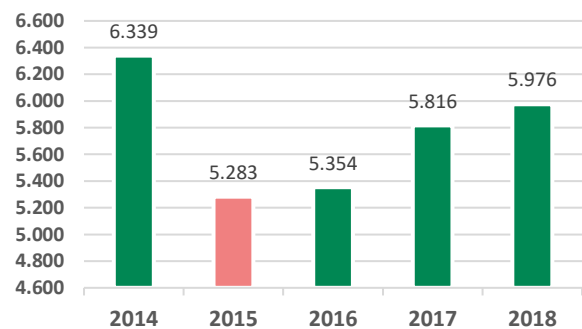
### GDP COMPOSITION BY REGION



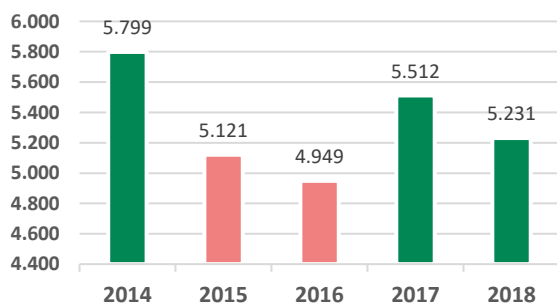
### GDP ASIA & PACIFICS IN BILLION USD



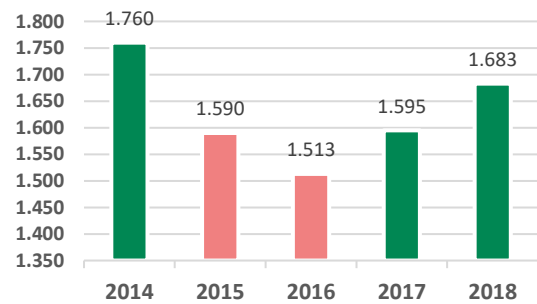
### GDP EMENA IN BILLION USD
